JHARKHAND STATE CENTRE, RANCHI 58TH ENGINEERS' DAY CALL FOR NOMNINATIONS FOR IEIJSC ENGINEERS' DAY AWARDS

The Institution of Engineers (India) has been observing 15th September every year as Engineers' Day to commemorate the birth anniversary of Bharat Ratna Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya. On this occasion, the following Awards, instituted by The Institution of Engineers (India), Jharkhand State Center, Ranchi are presented:

- **1.0 Bharat Ratna Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya Life time Achievement Award** for outstanding contribution in the field of Engineering (One Award).
- **2.0** The IEI Engineer of the Year Awards (Four awards) For specific contributions in any particular field of Engineering; one each from:
 - (i) Teaching & Research Area 1 No.
 - (ii) Engineers from Government and Public Sector 2 Nos.
 - (iii) Engineers from Private Sector/Other than (i) & (ii) 1 No.

If any category applications are not suitable for award, the award will be transferred to Government and Public sector award category (sl. no. ii above) depending on number of applications.

- **3.0 IEI Young Engineer of the Year Awards** (Two awards) For specific contributions in any particular field of Engineering; one each from:
 - (i) Academics &
 - (ii) Industry

If any category applications are not suitable for award, the award will be transferred to the other catagory depending on number of applications.

- **4.0 Dr. A. K. Chatterjee Best Paper Award** (Two Awards) For printed technical paper 1 number for IEI Corporate Member and 1 number for IEI Student Member.
- 5.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE AWARDS:
 - A. Bharat Ratna Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya Life time Achievement Award

The IEI Corporate Members of The Institution of Engineers (India), Jharkhand State Center and Dhanbad, Bokaro & Jamshedpur local centers, who are engaged as Professional Engineers or Technologists/Research Engineers/ Engineering Teachers are eligible for the Awards. The most significant and outstanding work or research contributions made should primarily be in Jharkhand State and carried out by the individual, during the five years immediately preceding the year of the Award, for the benefit of the people of Jharkhand State in particular or should represent a specific break-through in the field of Engineering/Technology. The applicant should be above 50 years of age as on 31.08.2025.

B. IEI Engineer of the Year Award

The IEI Corporate Members of The Institution of Engineers (India), Jharkhand State Center and Dhanbad, Bokaro & Jamshedpur local centers who are engaged as Professional Engineers or Technologist/Research Engineers/ Engineering Teachers are eligible for awards. The most significant and outstanding work or research contributions made should primarily be in Jharkhand State and should be carried by the individual during the five years immediately preceding the year of the Award for the benefit of the people of Jharkhand in particular, or should represent a specific break-through in the field of Engineering/Technology. The applicant should be above 35 years of age and below 50 years of age as on 31.08.2025.

C. IEI Young Engineer of the Year Award

The IEI Corporate Members of The Institution of Engineers (India), Jharkhand State Center and Dhanbad, Bokaro &

Jamshedpur local centers who are engaged as Professional Engineers or Technologist/Research Engineers/ Engineering Teachers are eligible for awards. The most significant and outstanding work or research contributions made should primarily be in Jharkhand State and should be carried by the individual during the five years immediately preceding the year of the Award for the benefit of the people of Jharkhand in particular, or should represent a specific break-through in the field of Engineering/Technology. The applicant should be below 35 years of age as on 31.08.2025.

D. Dr. A. K. Chatterjee Best Paper Award

The IEI Corporate and Student Members of The Institution of Engineers (India), Jharkhand State Center and Dhanbad, Bokaro & Jamshedpur local centers who are engaged as students/ research scholars/ working Engineers/ Engineering Teachers are eligible for awards. The papers considered for award shall be presented during study of Engineering degree course at their college or at any one day/ two day seminar/workshops elsewhere by student applicant. For other than Student applicants, the paper shall be published in reputed national/ international journals or proceedings of any seminars/ conferences (2-days duration).

The application can be submitted through a request letter enclosing 3 sets of printed paper/ Presentation copies. The application form attached as Annexure-1 is not applicable for the best paper award. No nominations are required for the best paper award, applicant may directly apply.

6.0 Nomination of the candidates for awards:

Nominations are invited from the Heads of Department; Vice Chancellor of Universities; Director of Research Laboratories; Industries and Fellows of The Institution of Engineers (India) etc. in the prescribed form attached with this notice and is available at www.ieijscjharkhand.org. The physical form may also be obtained on request from: The Chairman, Bharat Ratna Sir M Visvesvaraya Award Selection Committee-2025, The Institution of Engineers (India), Jharkhand State Centre, IEI Engineer Bhawan, Nepal Kothi Campus, Doranda, Ranchi - 834 002 from 01st Aug, 2025 onwards.

Nominations duly filled-in with necessary information along with two copies of latest Passport size colour photographs of Nominee and draft citation should reach us latest by 31st Aug, 2025 to the above address. The applications for Best paper award will also be accepted till 31st Aug, 2025.

6.1 Who are authorised to nominate for the awards (except for Dr. A. K. Chatterjee Best Paper Award):

- 1 Past or Present President of the approved Engineering Societies of All India Character with Technical Branches in Jharkhand.
- 2 Vice Chancellors of Universities / Deans of Engineering and Technology Faculties in Jharkhand.
- 3 Heads and Deans of Faculties of Institutions deemed to be of University status located in Jharkhand.
- 4 Engineer-in-Chief of the Government concerned department, like Industries; Energy, Science and Technology; Technical Education; Irrigation and CAD/Water Resources Dept; Transport and Communications etc.
- 5 The Present Council Members of the Institution of Engineers (India) from Jharkhand State.
- 6 Fellow Members of The Institution of Engineers (India), attached to Jharkhand State Centre including Dhanbad, Bokaro, Jamshedpur local centers (FIE's only).
- 7 CMD/ Directors/ Executive Directors/ Chief General Managers (E-8 & above) of Public and Private Sectors located in Jharkhand.
- 8 Bharat Ratna Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya Life Time Achievement Awardee can nominate one candidate in his/her own field of works within Jurisdiction of Jharkhand.

7.0 IMPORTANT POINTS

- 1. Information should be given in the space provided in the Nomination Form Only.
- 2. The information related to awards should be treated as Confidential.
- 3. The nomination by itself does not confer upon the candidate the right for being considered for the award and all applications shall be routed through the selection process.

- 5. The Nomination shall be for ONE AWARD per person only.
- 6. IN CASE OF NOMINEES WHO ARE EMPLOYED, THEIR NOMINATION SHOULD BE SIGNED BY THEIR EMPLOYER ONLY AND CAN BE SUBMITTED BY APPLICANT.
- The following Nominations SHALL BE REJECTED.
 - a. Self-nominated applicants.
 - b. Same person being nominated for more than one award.
 - c. Nomination forms not signed by the concerned Head of the Department or other than those authorized to nominate.
 - d. Incomplete nominations or those not following given guidelines.
 - e. Forwarded by Elected Executive Committee Members of IEIJSC, Dhanbad, Bokaro, Jamshedpur local centers.
- 8. Nomination shall be sent in a sealed cover only.
- 9. The material submitted along with the nomination will be property of the IEI, Jharkhand State Centre and there will be no copy right liability on IEI JSC.
- 10. The Nominations shall reach to The Chairman, Bharat Ratna Sir M Visvesvaraya Award Selection Committee 2025 latest by 31st Aug, 2025.
- 11. TA & DA shall not be paid by IEI, JSC. Applicant has to make his own arrangement for traveling & lodging to attend the award ceremony.
- 12. Awards will not be awarded in Absentia.
- 13. The presently serving Elected Executive Committee members of IEI, Jharkhand State Center, Dhanbad, Bokaro & Jamshedpur Local centers are not eligible for any of the above awards.
- 14. Those who have received any of the above Awards in any previous years by IEIJSC, their nomination will not be considered in the same category for award this year.
- 15. The documentary evidence for previous achievements, if any, shall be enclosed by the nominee along with the Nomination form.



1.0 Name and style of the Awards:

a) Bharat Ratna Sir M. Visvesvaraya Lifetime Achievement Award : One b) IEI Engineer of the Year Awards : Four

(i) Teaching & Research Area – 1 no, (ii) Engineers from

Government and Public Sector (2 nos.) and (iii) Engineers from

Private Sector / Consultancy / NGO's - 1 no.

(If any category applications are not suitable for award, the award will be transferred to Government and Public sector award category depending on number of applications).

c) IEI Young Engineer of the Year Awards

one each from Academics and Industry d) Dr. A.K. Chatterjee Best Paper Award

one each for IEI Corporate and Student member

2.0 Objective of the Award:

2.1 Bharat Ratna Sir M. Visvesvaraya Lifetime Achievement Award

To recognize the outstanding contributions made by the recipient in the field of engineering and technology. To generate and encourage application of science and technology for promotion of material welfare of the people.

2.2 IEI Engineer of the Year Award/ IEI Young Engineer of the Year Award

To the specific contribution in any particular fields of engineering which will indicate the development capabilities of the engineers.

3.0 Nature of the Awards:

3.1 Bharat Ratna Sir M. Visvesvaraya Life Time Achievement Award carries with it:

(For the age group of above 50 years)

- a) A citation to be read out at the Engineers' Day Function.
- b) A Certificate of the Award.
- c) A Cheque (A/c payee) of Rs. 5,000/-
- d) A Memento.

3.2 IEI Engineer of the Year Award carries with it:

(for the age group of above 35 years and below 50 years of age)

- a) A citation to be read out at the Engineers' Day Function.
- b) A Certificate of the Award.
- c) A Cheque (A/c payee) of Rs. 2,000/-
- d) A Memento.

3.3 IEI Young Engineer of the Year Award carries with it:

(for the age group upto 35 years)

- a) A Certificate of the Award.
- b) A Cheque (A/c payee) of Rs. 1,000/-.
- c) A Memento.

3.4 Dr. A.K. Chatterjee Best Paper Award carries with it:

(for IEI Student / Corporate members)

- a) A Certificate of the Award.
- b) A Memento.

4.0 Eligibility and Criteria for the Award:

- 4.1 The nominee should be Corporate / Student Member (as applicable) of The Institution of Engineers (India) or may have applied for membership of IEI on or before 31.08.2025.
- 4.2 The Corporate members of the Institution of Engineers (India), Jharkhand State Center and Dhanbad, Bokaro & Jamshedpur Local centers engaged as Practicing Engineer or Technologist/ Research Engineer/Engineering Teacher, are eligible for the Engineers Day Awards.
- 4.3 The outstanding work or research contribution made should primarily be in Jharkhand and should have been carried out during the five years immediately preceding the year of the Award for the benefit of the people of Jharkhand or should represent a specific break-through in the field of Engineering/Technology.
- 4.4 The Awards will be presented to the persons who in the final opinion of the Award Selection Committee have made important and outstanding contribution, specific contribution in the field of the work of the candidate towards the welfare of the humanity in general and the people of Jharkhand in particular. For this purpose, specific contribution of individual in the field of Engineering and Technology will be the sole predominant criterion for evaluation.
- 4.5 For the best paper award, the applications are invited from Engineering students who are IEI student members and Corporate Members of any age group are eligible and the paper submitted for award shall be of at their college level or of any international/ national seminar / conferences / symposiums of two days duration.

5.0 Fields of Works:

5.1 Awards may be presented for notable and outstanding work in the fields of:

- 1. Aerospace Engineering
- 2. Agricultural Engineering
- 3. Civil Engineering
- 4. Chemical Engineering
- 5. Electrical Engineering
- 6. Electronics and Telecom Engineering
- 7. Mechanical Engineering
- 8. Textile Engineering
- 9. Industrial Engineering
- 10. Genetic Engineering

- 11. Satellite Technology
- 12. Computer Science Engineering
- 13. Metallurgy & Materials Science Engineering
- 14. Design and Development
- 15. Environmental Engineering
- 16. Bio-Medical Engineering
- 17. Inter-Disciplinary fields
- 18. Fuel Technology
- 19. Other fields of Engineering & Technology
- 5.2 The above list is only to broadly indicate the fields but the work should be in general belong to the area of Engineering, Science and Technology.

6.0 Nominations:

- 6.1 The Award Selection Committee will select the nominations received by them. The nominations should be made in the standard proforma annexed. The Award Committee invites nominations each year from the nominating organizations/ engineers to nominate as per the regulations governing the Award.
- 7.0 All the decisions of the IEI JSC Award Selection Committee are final and binding.
